E-Mail Fraud

If you receive any e-Mail messages such as the one below, or e-Mail messages similar to it in which someone is impersonating an employee at the Canada Revenue Agency and asking you to contact your bank and provide information by e-Mail, **do not reply**.

These messages have all the warning signs of fraud because of the incomplete or suspicious information, the poor quality of the logo reproduction, or in this case, a federal government e-Mail address which is incorrect and not bilingual.

These types of e-Mail messages are "scams" from people who want to steal your money and/or your personal information. Exercise caution at all times. **Delete these messages from your e-Mail in box immediately upon receiving them.**
